CASA receives donation from Schreiber Charity Golf Classic

Green Bay, WI – Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of Brown County was one of two beneficiaries from the annual Schreiber Charity Golf Classic outing held July 25, 2011. Suppliers and partners of Schreiber Foods recently donated \$100,000 toward the cause of advocating for children who come to the attention of the courts because of abuse or neglect. Unity Hospice also received \$100,000 from the outing.

“We will use a portion of the funds to create an endowment to help provide for our long-term future, and will use the balance to provide immediate services for children here in Brown County who are in the court system because they have been abused or neglected,” said Connie Greenawald, CASA executive director. We are very grateful to Schreiber and all of their participating suppliers.”

Each year the outing raises money for deserving non-profit organizations. More than 60 suppliers from across the country participated in the event.

“The children who benefit from CASA services are the true winners - children right here in our community who need it most,” Greenawald said.

Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of Brown County, Inc. is a non-profit organization that advocates for the best interests of abused and neglected children in the court system. CASA of Brown County recruits, screens, and trains caring, committed citizens from the community to provide close, consistent contact with the children they serve, seeking to assure them a safe and permanent home. CASA volunteers act as the "eyes and ear of the court," making independent observations about the safety and well-being of the children, and communicating that information to the judges making decisions about their future.
