Recycle your old electronics to benefit CASA!

Green Bay, WI – Cyber Green is holding an electronic recycling event to benefit children in our communities through CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) of Brown County. The event is being held **Wednesday, September 21st from 7:00 am to 2:00 pm** at Green Bay Insurance Center, 417 South Monroe, Green Bay.

Children who have been abused or neglected are often assigned a CASA volunteer by the juvenile judge. Because CASA is mandated to have a paid Volunteer Supervisor for every 30 volunteer Advocates, funds are being raised to continue to provide children in Brown County with this extremely important service. CASA's mission is to provide trained volunteers to represent the voice of abused and neglected children in court. The primary goal of CASA volunteers is to provide close, consistent, one-on-one support to the children they are assigned, and to provide the court with detailed reports to help assure those children a safe and permanent home.

The more pounds we collect, the more CASA benefits!

ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING AT NO FEE: computers, laptops, printers, keyboards, mice (you know what kind we mean!), LCDs, servers, fax machines, wire and cabling, telephone systems, modems, stereo systems, video equipment, cell phones, copiers (liquid purged), microwaves, dehumidifiers, appliances, and mechanical equipment.

ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING WITH A FEE: CRT monitors, TVs and picture tubes. 29" and less = \$10; 30" and larger = \$20. (Please note: These display devices contain hazardous materials (lead) that incurs a disposal cost. Thank you in advance! In the event of any proceeds from this event, they will be donated to CASA of Brown County to help advocate for children who have been abused or neglected.)

NOTE: All hard drives will be shredded. PLEASE DON'T BRING: Light bulbs, old media or software, bio hazards (blood/fluids), mercury or paint.

Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of Brown County, Inc. is a non-profit organization that advocates for the best interests of abused and neglected children in the juvenile court system. CASA of Brown County recruits, screens, and trains caring, committed citizens from the community to provide close, consistent contact with the children they serve, seeking to assure them a safe and permanent home. CASA volunteers act as the "eyes and ear of the court," making independent observations about the safety and well-being of the children, and communicating that information to the judges making decisions about their future.
