CASA volunteers provide a voice for abused and neglected children who are under the legal protection of the court system.

Our vision is for every child to feel safe and secure in their home and heart.

CASA volunteers visit with their CASA child regularly and submit monthly reports to the juvenile judge about the child's safety and well-being to help the judge make important decisions about the child's future.

A CASA volunteer is very often the only consistent adult presence in the life of an abused or neglected child. CASA volunteers make a lasting impact on the lives of the most vulnerable children in our community.
