**49 new CASA volunteers** were recruited, screened, and trained by CASA staff.



**51 youth** participated in our Fostering Futures program, developing skills and setting goals to help transition successfully to independence.



**59 children** reached a safe, permanent home.



**13 young adults** joined the Transition Aged Youth (TAY) pilot program.
