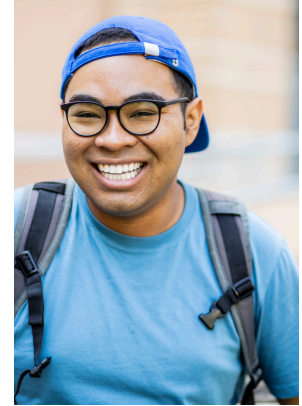


Transition Aged Youth (TAY) Program

FUTURE OF TAY

- **recruit and train** additional mentors.
- **develop ongoing training** for mentors.
